

Please use this as a guide to walk you through the steps of preparing your pet for travel to Hawaii and Direct Release.

Rabies Vaccination #1 (*you must retain copies of all Rabies Vaccination Certificates*)

Enter Rabies Vaccination #1 Date:

Wait at least 30 days from date of 1st Rabies Vaccination

Rabies Vaccination # 2

Enter Rabies Vaccination # 2 Date:

Implant Microchip if it has not already been done.

Wait at least 30 days from date of Rabies Vaccination #2

FAVN Rabies Antibody Test

Date of FAVN:

Wait 30 days

Obtain a copy of FAVN results from your Veterinarian

Enter Date of FAVN Results:

Contact Kaua'i North Shore Animal Clinic for Direct Release Request Form

Book Flight (must be at least 30 days from the date AQS receives paperwork)

Submit Paperwork to State of Hawaii (must be 30 days or more before planned arrival)

Submit Kaua'i North Shore Animal Clinic - Direct Release Request Form

1-10 days prior to arrival:

Veterinarian treats pet with a long acting product labeled to kill ticks

Health Certificate (an letter of acclimation if your airline requires)
